MILITARY RECRUITERS ACCESS TO STUDENT INFORMATION CONSENT

To be completed by 11th and 12th grade parents only.

The *No Child Left Behind Federal Education Legislation* requires all high schools to provide military recruiters with the names, addresses and phone numbers of all 11th and 12th grade students. A school's failure to comply with this requirement could result in a loss of federal education funding under the *Elementary and Secondary Education Act* that was signed into law in January, 2002.

Parents/guardians have the option of deciding if their child's information is to be released to military recruiters. I understand that if I do not 'opt out' by the established deadline (September 30) then student information will be released in accordance with the Federal Education Legislation.

PLEASE NOTE: *The consent status identified on this form will remain in effect for the duration of the current school year. Changes to the consent status can be made in the submission of forms for the following high school year.*
