We have envisioned a "Student One-to-One" computing environment as a pathway to a more student-centered, 21st century education, as instructional practices shift to take advantage of the new learning opportunities available.

For this coming school year, the District will continue to issue Chromebook devices to our incoming Freshman Class. This will be an important step in the process of achieving the "One-to-One" computing environment that we have envisioned for all Hunterdon Central students. The plan for distributing these devices to our students will be provided in forthcoming communications.

Hunterdon Central also offers students the option of using personally-owned devices within the high school's learning environment with our program called "BYOD" - Bring Your Own Device.

All students at Hunterdon Central will continue to have the option to join the guest network and bring their personally-owned devices to the high school.
