Media Consent & Videotaping Consent for Athletes

Hunterdon Central's student athletes are frequently photographed by local media while participating in athletic competitions; they are also sometimes interviewed by reporters after an athletic event. These situations are considered to be in the public domain and require no specific parental consent. In addition to these instances, sometimes the media will attend a practice and interview coaches and student athletes, or will interview or photograph a student athlete who has received an honor, such as being named Athlete of the Week. By signing the *UNIFIED CONSENT FORM*, parents/guardians give their consent to allow the media to interview or photograph their son/daughter, within the context of their participation in Hunterdon Central athletics.

Hunterdon Central also frequently videotapes athletic games, matches and meets for broadcast on HCTV-Channel 27, the District's 24/7 cable television station. By signing the *UNIFIED CONSENT FORM*, parents/guardians give their consent to allow their son/daughter be videotaped by Hunterdon Central's HCTV-Channel 27, for broadcast on the television station, or for other educational use.

Occasionally, an outside television station such as Comcast or News12 New Jersey will tape and broadcast Hunterdon Central's athletic events. By signing the *UNIFIED CONSENT FORM*, parents/guardians give their consent to allow their son/daughter to be videotaped by outside media outlets, with the context of their participation in Hunterdon Central athletics.
