

The New Jersey Department of Education recently released information on State-mandated standardized tests that makes it necessary for this year's AP testing schedule to be changed. This email contains updated information on AP testing.

Hunterdon Central is implementing the following changes to the AP testing schedule.

- All **AP World Language exams, and the Music Theory exam** will still be administered in-school during the Administration 1 period, from May 3 -17.
- Due to the format of the **Math/Science** exams and required demonstration of work, students will be given the option to test in-school. The in-person option will be administered during Administration 2, from May 18 - 28. Students registered to take **Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Chemistry, Physics C: Mechanics, Physics C: E&M, Physics 1 and Statistics** will be allowed to change their exam from digital at-home (Administration 3), to in-school/paper and pencil (Administration 2). Registered students will receive an email on March 22 or 23 with information on the change process.
- All other AP exams will be changed to digital at-home testing, during the Administration 2 period, from May 18 - 28, and the Administration 3 period, from June 4 - 11. Students and parents will receive future email communications with the specifics of their assigned test date, test location, reporting time and staging areas. In addition, students testing digitally at home will receive information on the technical preparations necessary for their test.

All students testing in-school will receive an email with specific details regarding test dates, report time, testing and staging locations, as well as what items should, and should not, be brought to the testing site. Students testing digitally at-home will receive an email the day before the exam reminding them of the date and time of the exam.

Students are expected to sit for the exam on their scheduled date, time, and location. Students who have two exams in one day (back-to-back) are expected to test as scheduled, as per College Board policy. If you have a conflict with two AP exams scheduled at the same time, please contact Ms. Givas at sandra.givas@hcrhs.org. Please provide your student's first and last name, AP exam name, dates and times that conflict in your email

With the exception of the Math/Science option noted above, students will not be able to change the assigned date/time of their Administration 1 or Administration 2 exam. Any other conflicts or illness should be communicated to Ms. Givas at sandra.givas@hcrhs.org. Students who wish to cancel their exams can cancel with a full refund through April 9.
