Survey Consent

In order to be in compliance with directives issued by the State of New Jersey, schools must obtain parental consent in order to survey students regarding behaviors related to adolescent social and health issues. On occasion, Hunterdon Central surveys students regarding these issues, usually in our health classes. This allows the high school to target areas of concern and design services and programs to address these areas and meet the needs of students and their families, based on the survey results. Names are never collected as part of the survey process, so all information remains anonymous.

Vocational Consent

The Governor signed legislation requiring all school districts to provide pupil directory information to county vocational schools, upon request. This bill requires that a school district provide the county vocational school with the names and addresses of all students enrolled in the district, grades nine through twelve.

Military Consent (Only for Grades 11 and 12 Students)

Under the federal Elementary and Secondary Education Act, public high schools must give the names, addresses and telephone numbers of students to military recruiters. A school's failure to comply with this requirement could result in a loss of federal education funding under the *Elementary and Secondary Education Act*, which was signed into law in January, 2002.

Parents/guardians have the right to instruct Hunterdon Central in writing that this information is not to be released.
